

Reception Tents

There are 3 main styles of tents, most often used for events & additional specialty tent options for unique & specific event requests.

Main Tent Styles & Types-

Frame Tents: Offer an open floor plan, layout, & design for your event as all the poles/tent support structures are solely around the perimeter of the tent allowing of open and unobstructed space inside. These tents are typically covered with white tops & can be enclosed with solid white or window sidewalls depending on weather & climate control needs & conditions. Lighting options for these tents are vast from different styles of string lights to stunning chandeliers as well as the ability to leave the ceiling structure exposed or covered with solid fabrics or strands of fabrics.

Clear Top Frame Tents: Offer an open floor plan, layout, & design for your event as all the poles/tent support structures are solely around the perimeter of the tent allowing of open and unobstructed space inside. These tents are covered with clear tops & can be enclosed with clear sidewalls depending on weather & climate control needs & conditions. These tents are ideal for spring and autumn events, especially events held during daylight hours set among picturesque scenery. Lighting options for these tents are vast from different styles of string lights to stunning chandeliers as well as the ability to leave the ceiling structure exposed or decorated with strands of fabrics.

Pole Tents: These tents typically offer the most economical selection for tenting options. Based on a tall center pole creating a high peak. Depending on the size of the tent (total length & width) these tents can be set up with double poles depending on the width, and multiple single pole down the middle or sets of double poles down the length of the tent, depending on the overall length. The longer the tent the more center poles it will have. A downside to this style of tent is the large/tall center poles that must be designed around for event layout and floor plans. Creates the possibility of having a pole in the middle of a dance floor as well as a potential visual barrier to view the entire festivities.

Sailcloth Tents: The soft, creamy white/ivory panels of the Sailcloth Tent set it apart from other tents —as do the natural wooden poles and the hand-stitched detailing around the edges, signature pennant flags at the top of sculpted peaks and eaves. With a hint of nautical flair these tents create a luxury feel with a canvas that glows like no other under the evening lights. With a unique ability to be dressed up or down, sailcloth tents are fit for chic rustic events themes as well. The beauty and sophistication of these tents create a statement of their own that only adds to your event.

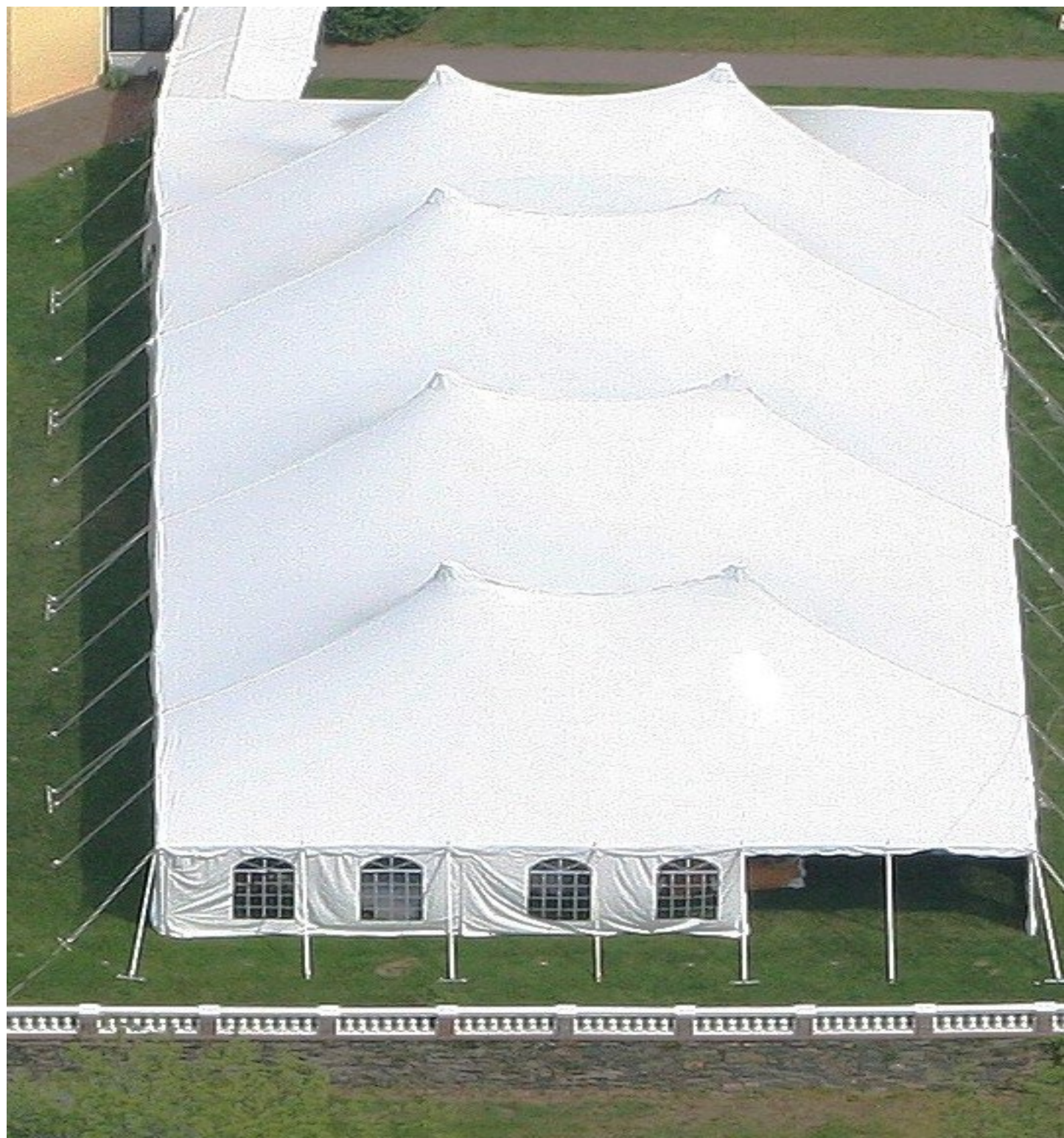

Tent pricing is based upon tent type, size, and additional items like lighting & sidewalls.

Seated events with 120-150 guests require a minimum tent size of 40 feet wide by 80 feet long.
